

How to play "ready golf"



It's quite a simple concept: golfers should play in the order they are ready, not necessarily in the order deemed by the rules of golf. For casual rounds, don't worry about who is away from the hole or who has the honor on the next tee. If you are ready, and you aren't in anyone's way, alert your group you are playing your next shot and hit it. Of course, this less formal style should be established with your playing partners before or early in your round. Provided everyone keeps an eye on what everyone else in the group is doing, it's the kind of request that isn't likely to be denied.
